

Grants to community groups and agencies

The Beaubassin-est Rural Community invites organizations and community groups to submit a request to receive a financial contribution. Grant applications will be evaluated according to the following evaluation criteria:

- Grant applications are made by a non-profit community organization / group that serves the population of Beaubassin-est;
- The requested grants must help to organize specific activities of the organization / group that will have an impact on the community;
- Priority will be given to grant applications that will be used to help people in need in the municipality.

Funding applications are evaluated twice a year, deadlines for submission of the Grant Application Form are March 31st and October 31st. Thanks to the support program for community organizations, Beaubassin-est awarded approximately \$24,000 in grants to organizations for the year 2018.

In March 2019, Beaubassin-est awarded a \$3,000 grant to the "La Bouquinière" project at Donat-Robichaud School and a \$7,000 grant for the redevelopment of the playground. Father-Edgar-T.-LeBlanc School.
