

Beaubassin-est Scholarship

Students from Beaubassin-est have until April 30th at 4 pm to submit a scholarship application. The draw for the \$ 1,000 scholarship will be made during the regular meeting on Tuesday, May 21st, 2019 at 7 pm. Following a recommendation from the Community and Cultural Pride Committee, the council decided to increase the amount of its scholarship from \$ 500 to \$ 1,000.

Any person that meets the following criteria may apply for the scholarship by completing the necessary form and bringing it to the municipality. Applicants must:

- be permanent residents of the municipality;
- have obtained a high school diploma or be on the list of graduates for the current year;
- continue training in first year of an undergraduate program in a post-secondary institution and not have pursued post-secondary education before; and
- be 25 years old or less.

The winner will receive the scholarship in January 2020 after presenting a document from the postsecondary institution certifying enrollment in a program of study that meets the criteria and his readmission for the second term of the school year. If the training is completed before the month of January 2020, a document certifying that the student has met the requirements of the training program will be required before receiving the scholarship.

The municipality awarded its 2018 scholarship to Marc Thibodeau from Grand-Barachois.
